

AN ORDINANCE 2009-03-19-0206

**AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2008-12-11-1163, TO INCREASE THE AIRPORT ADVISORY COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP BY TWO MEMBERS, AND APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE COMMISSION.**

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**WHEREAS**, the Airport Advisory Commission (AAC) was created on December 12, 2008 by Ordinance No. 2008-12-11-1163 with seventeen members to advise the Aviation Director regarding matters effecting the City's airports and air transportation initiatives, to include noise related matters; and

**WHEREAS**, the Economic and Community Development Council Committee met on March 3, 2009, and provided recommendations for the seventeen members of the AAC; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to expand the board's membership by adding an additional member to the Community and Business Community categories; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** Ordinance No. 2008-12-11-1163 is amended to add two additional members to the Commission, as reflected by Section 2, below.

**SECTION 2.** Priscilla R. Richer, Kyle A. Gish, and Sandee L. Taylor (Category: Aviation industry); Edward A. Benson, Richard Kelley, Mark Tafolla, Donald R. Davie, Verner Eglit and Donna K Schneider (Category: Community); Marco A. Barros and Marsha Hendler (Category: Travel and Tourism Industry); Jeff C. McConie, Jesse A. Sanchez, Loren G. Wood, and Neil A. Stone (Category: Business Community); Jim C. Rowell (Category: Taxi Cab Industry); Todd M. Post (Category: Airport Business - Lessee); Gloria C. Arriaga (Category: Alamo Area Council of Governments); and Tom F. Bowman (Category: Federal Aviation Administration) are appointed to the Airport Advisory Commission for one and two year terms of office, expiring May 31, 2010 and 2011, to be determined at the first meeting.


**SECTION 3.** The City Code residency requirement is waived for the appointment of Sandra Taylor.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight (8) affirmative votes, or in the event eight affirmative votes are not received, on the tenth day after passage.
