#### AN ORDINANCE 2009 - 09 - 17 - 0731K

MODIFYING FEES ASSOCIATED WITH THE SAN ANTONIO POLICE DEPARTMENT; AND AMENDING THE RELEVANT SECTIONS OF THE CITY CODE TO REFLECT SUCH CHANGES.

\* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \*

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City of San Antonio to assess fees to offset the costs of providing services; and

WHEREAS, as a part of the FY2010 City budget development process, there has been identified the need to modify fees charged by the San Antonio Police Department; NOW THEREFORE:

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** Subsection 25-6(e) of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is hereby amended, in its entirety, as follows:

The police department is authorized to charge a fee of six dollars (\$6.00) for each traffic accident report and is authorized to charge an additional fee of two dollars (\$2.00) to certify each traffic accident report.

**SECTION 2.** Subsection 25-6(j) of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is hereby established as follows:

The police department is authorized to charge an application processing fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for the processing of criminal history reviews of applicants who have submitted applications to the City of San Antonio.

**SECTION 3.** Section 25-10 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is hereby established as follows:

The police department is authorized to charge a property processing fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for the processing of all personal property, except that personal property being retrieved by or returned to victims. The term "personal property," as used in this

subsection, shall refer to property which, at the time of its release, is not classified as evidence, recovered property, or found property.

**SECTION 4.** Subsection 25-57(b) of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is hereby amended, in its entirety, as follows:

A fee of forty dollars (\$40.00) shall be charged for the issuance and renewal of each permit issued for a residential alarm site; however, a fee of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) shall be charged for the issuance and renewal of each permit issued for a residential alarm site to a person 65 years or older who is eligible for a homestead exemption. A fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) shall be charged for the issuance and renewal of each permit issued for a commercial alarm site.

**SECTION 5.** Subsection 25-66(a) of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is hereby amended, in its entirety, as follows:

Except as provided in subsections (b), (c) and (d), the holder of an alarm permit shall pay a service fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the fourth and fifth false burglary alarm notification emitted from such alarm system in the preceding 12-month period, seventyfive dollars (\$75.00) for the sixth and seventh false burglary alarm notification emitted in the preceding 12-month period, and one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each false burglary alarm notification emitted in excess of seven in the preceding 12-month period; two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for the second false robbery or false manually activated emergency assistance alarm notification emitted from such alarm system in the preceding 12-month period, three hundred dollars (\$300.00) for the third false robbery or false manually activated emergency assistance alarm notification emitted from such alarm system in the preceding 12-month period, four hundred dollars (\$400.00) for the fourth false robbery or false manually activated emergency assistance alarm notification emitted from such alarm system in the preceding 12-month period, five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for the fifth and each subsequent false robbery or false manually activated emergency assistance alarm notification emitted from such alarm system in the preceding 12-month period; and fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the fourth false fire, smoke, or heat alarm notification emitted from such alarm system within the preceding 12-month period and one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each emitted in excess of four in the preceding 12month period.

**SECTION 6.** Should any article, section, part, paragraph, sentence, phrase, clause, or word of this ordinance, for any reason, be held illegal, inoperative, or invalid, or if any exception to or limitation upon any general provision herein contained be held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective, the remainder shall, nevertheless, stand effective and valid as if it had been enacted and ordained without the portion held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective.

**SECTION 7.** The publishers of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas are authorized to amend said code to reflect the changes adopted herein and to correct typographical errors and to format and number paragraphs to conform to the existing code.

**SECTION 8.** This ordinance shall take effect October 1, 2009.
