

AN ORDINANCE 2007-02-01-0120

APPROVING A \$200,000 AMENDMENT TO AN INDEFINITE DELIVERY PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH HNTB CORPORATION FOR ADDITIONAL AS NEEDED SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH CITY-WIDE SIDEWALK, STREET AND NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, a professional services contract was authorized by Ordinance No. 99636 on September 2, 2004 with HNTB Corporation and Bain Medina Bain, Inc. in the amount of \$400,000.00 for each consultant to provide as-needed professional engineering and construction administration services in connection with City-Wide Sidewalk, Street and Neighborhood Improvement Projects; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance appropriates payment up to an additional \$200,000.00 to **HNTB Corporation** for additional professional engineering and construction administration services on an as-needed basis which consists of engineering support to identify necessary sidewalk projects, through gap analysis software products; and

WHEREAS, the City will continue to utilize services under this agreement to expedite project delivery and completion to include the construction or reconstruction of sidewalks, ADA improvements, neighborhood traffic calming, drainage, streets, and other infrastructure improvements; **NOW THEREFORE**,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The professional services agreement between the City of San Antonio and **HNTB Corporation** which was originally authorized by Ordinance 99636 dated September 2, 2004 is hereby amended. The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to execute said amendment, a copy of which is in substantially the form attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**.

SECTION 2. Funds for these services in amount not to exceed \$200,000 are authorized to be payable to HNTB Corporation and shall be allocated as required from project funds which will be identified as work orders are issued. The Director of Finance is authorized to make the necessary transfers when the specific work orders are identified and assigned. No funds are being appropriated with this item.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect on the 11th day of February, 2007.


